Three of the buttons illustrate a fox running at speed, hounds in full pursuit and the kill.... The other three buttons illustrate a horse in harness, a dog sniffing scents and a man loading a shotgun with his dog beside him.

These 18th century buttons are highly collectable and would look very good on a formal or velvet jacket of today.

The buttons are each clearly stamped on the reverse with makers mark only and the lion passant.
